At White Oryx Academy, we want everyone to enjoy sport, learn new skills, and feel safe and supported. This Code of Conduct is for all children and young people taking part in our activities. It sets out how we treat each other and what it means to be part of our team and community.

As a member of White Oryx Academy, I will:

- Be kind, respectful, and polite to my teammates, coaches, match officials, and everyone around me.
- Try my best in training and matches, even when things are challenging.
- Listen carefully to coaches and follow their instructions to stay safe and improve.
- Include others and support my teammates win or lose, we play as a team.
- Tell an adult I trust (like a coach or my parent) if I feel upset, worried, or unsafe.
- Take care of equipment, kit, and facilities as if they were my own.
- Celebrate effort and be proud of my progress and others' achievements.
- Respect all cultures, beliefs, and backgrounds, and treat everyone fairly.

X I will not:

- Bully, tease, or hurt others in any way this includes verbal, physical, or online bullying.
- Use rude or offensive language, gestures, or behaviour.
- Be aggressive, cheat, or behave unfairly in games or training.
- Leave the training area or facility without permission from a coach or staff member.
- Bring dangerous or banned items (e.g. weapons, vapes, energy drinks).
- Share or post inappropriate content or messages online about teammates, coaches, or the Academy.



If I break the Code...

- I understand that I may be spoken to by a coach or staff member.
- My parents or guardians might be informed.
- I may be asked to take a break from a session or, in serious cases, miss future sessions or be removed from the Academy programme.
